Explanation to administration of License Action

The explanation below is more embarrassing than anything else. I have been fined as well as placed on a probationary status for a situation back in 2002. I will give a brief history of the chain of events, however I have now completed all requirements imposed.

I was originally licensed in Florida in late 2000 and then in Georgia later in 2001. In the year of 2002 I was hired to do an Auction for some cabinet shop tools. The Auction resulted in all the tools selling. One party whom owned the cabinet shop was happy and the other person (the girlfriend whom loaned the cabinet shop owner the money to start his business was not) There was some ad valorem taxes due and I was aware of that fact, I had a conversation with the Tax Collector about the amount due of 234.00. I made aware the owner of the tools that this was due and in fact stated that this was paid and that he would insure that I received the receipt of the payment. I settled with the owner of the tools and paid him in full. I received notice from the tax collector that the taxes had not been paid and that they were asking the girlfriend for the taxes. The Tax collector again called me and I tried in earnest to contact the owner of the tools and could not find him, and I learned later that he moved to North Carolina. I PAID the tax collector in full after not being able to contact the seller. The Tax Collector and the Girlfriend (She being employed by the state attorneys general office) filed a complaint against me with the Florida Board of Auctioneers. I had not done anything wrong, I paid taxes, I settled with the owner, I complied with all the rules of the Auctioneers commission, however I did not pay the taxes under the timeline specified by the rules. I paid the taxes 32 days after the Auction and the rules state that all payments of money belonging to another must occur within 30 days after the auction. I continued to fight the complaint for several years and it seemed like a change in attorney's every month (turn over at the state I guess) it prolonged and I thought the complaint had went away because there was no substantial grounds to warrant the complaint. However in 2005 another State Attorney called and stated who he was and that this case needed to be resolved. The only fact that the state was able to produce was that I had paid the taxes outside the 30-day period.

During this time period in February of 2006, my license renewal in Georgia came up and as a standard procedure I was in the process of renewing my license and I had to answer a question that ask if I had ever been reprimanded by any state agency and at the time I answered the question the answer was no. This was an online question with no room for additional comments when I answered no. At this Time I had not been any action taken against my license or me. So later that year I had agreed to stipulate to a fine and a probation period for the Florida Complaint, and when the state board approved the stipulation it went into effect retroactive to 2005. In turn when this went into effect the order was technically in advance of my license renewal questionnaire in GA. The state of GA push the fact that I gave misleading information. I answered the questionnaire truthfully as stated on the application and intended to mislead no one, however once again caught in a situation that I feel that I did not do anything wrong I was faced with a decision to stipulate to an agreement that my attorney and the attorney for the state of GA

worked out and it seemed that I had no choice but to agree. In hind site I would have paid the 234.00 for the seller of the tools back in 2002. I really felt like I was doing the right thing with no intentions of any wrongdoing. I have paid my penalty and this is the only instance since 2002 and 2006.
