

## MEMORANDUM IN OPPOSITION TO PROPOSED JUDGMENT REQUESTING ASSESSMENT OF COURT COSTS TO DEFENDANT AND ORDER DENYING DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO STRIKE

### MAY IT PLEASE THE COURT:

Defendant, Sandy Edmonds, through undersigned counsel, submits the following Memorandum in Opposition to a Judgment filed by plaintiff, Robert Burns, on December 27, 2011, for the following reasons:

Plaintiff, Robert Burns, has filed a Judgment with this Court seeking an order denying defendant's Special Motion to Strike and requesting assessment of Court costs in the amount of \$402 that plaintiff incurred in filing a Memorandum in Opposition to Ms. Edmond's Exception of No Cause of Action and Special Motion to Strike. This matter last came for hearing on November 14, 2011, in order for the Court to hear oral arguments and accept evidence in regard to defendant's Exception of No Cause of Action, and Special Motion to Strike. The Court granted Ms. Edmonds' Exception of No Cause of Action, at plaintiff's costs. The Court granted Ms. Edmonds' Exception of No Cause of Action, at plaintiff's costs. The Court did not issue an order in regard to Ms. Edmonds' Special Motion to Strike, as this Motion became moot in light of the Court granting Ms. Edmonds' Exception of No Cause of Action. Pursuant to the Court's findings, a Judgment was submitted for the Court's signature. The Judgment was signed by this Court on November 30, 2011. Attached and identified as "Exhibit A" is a copy of the Judgment signed by the Court.

Following the filing of the Court's Judgment into the suit record, plaintiff filed an Amended Petition on December 9, 2011. Ms. Edmonds has re-urged her previous Exception of No Cause of Action and, also, excepts to the Amended Petition on the grounds it has not been properly served on Ms. Edmonds, as required by the Louisiana Code of Civil Procedure. Plaintiff argues in his Memorandum, filed with the proposed Judgment, that he is entitled to an award of "Reasonable attorney's fees and costs". Plaintiff failed to cite any legal basis for an award against Ms. Edmonds for Court costs he incurred in opposing defendant's Exception of No Cause of Action, particularly given the Court's judgment specifically awarded costs to defendant. Ms. Edmonds has not re-urged her Special Motion to Strike in light of Mr. Burns' failure to allege any cause of action in his Amended Petition. Plaintiff's proposed Judgment should be denied, and his Amended Petition dismissed, as Mr. Burns does not allege any new material and relevant facts to support any cause of action against Ms. Edmonds.


