Unlawful Exercise of Notarial Power


Dear Mr. Burns:

I received your letter/complaint of August 30, 2016, including evidence of your complaint likewise made to Mr. Jeffery Sallet, FBI, New Orleans, Louisiana, the Notary Division of the Secretary of State; and a copy of a complaint form to the Officer of the Governor, Auctioneers Licensing Board. I also note that you also copied your letter to the Louisiana Attorney General's Office, Brandon Freeman Head of Criminal Investigations.

The action which you complain of, the exercise of notarial power by Marvin Henderson, did not occur in the Parish of Lafayette (despite the fact that the "cash sale deed" purportedly notarized by Marvin A. Henderson in the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana may have been or was recorded in the Parish of Lafayette). In any event, I, by copy of this correspondence to the Louisiana Attorney General's Office, would echo your request in referring the matter further to the Attorney General for further examination, investigation, and/or review for criminal prosecution.
